





Detective Panda

Ten honey bee fun facts

- 1. Bees have five eyes
- 2. Bees fly about 20 mph
- 3. Number of eggs laid by queen bee: 2,000 per day!
- 4. Bees have been around for about 30 million years!
- 5. An average beehive can hold 50,000 bees
- 6. Forager bees must collect nectar from about two million flowers to make one pound of honey
- 7. The average forager makes about 1/12 th of a teaspoon of honey in her lifetime
- 8. Bees have two pairs of wings
- 9. Honey bees communicate using chemicals called phermones
- 10. Bees are important because they pollinate approximately 130 agricultural crops in the U.S.





Falling for Panda

For years, scientists have worked to understand the changes that occur in trees and shrubs during autumn. Three factors influence autumn leaf color: leaf pigments, length of night and weather.

The timing of color changes and the onset of falling leaves are primarily regulated by the calendar as nights become longer. As days grow shorter, and nights grow longer and cooler, biochemical processes in the leaf begin to paint the landscape with nature's autumn palette.



Pierre Panda

Whether you're lucky enough to have visited Paris, or have only ever dreamed of going there, chances are you know of the French capital's most beloved landmark: the Eiffel Tower.

The Eiffel Tower, "La Tour Eiffel" in French, was the main exhibit of the Paris Exposition — or World's Fair — of 1889. It was constructed to commemorate the centennial of the French Revolution and to demonstrate France's industrial prowess to the world.

Seven Eiffel Tower fun facts

- 1. Gustave Eiffel used latticed wrought iron to construct the tower to demonstrate that metal could be as strong as stone, while also being lighter.
- 2. Eiffel also created the internal frame for the Statue of Liberty.
- 3. The tower was built to sway slightly in the wind, but the sun affects the tower more. As the sun-facing side of the tower heats up, the top moves as much as seven inches (18 centimeters) away from the sun.
- 4. The sun also causes the tower to grow about six inches.
- 5. The Eiffel Tower weighs 10,000 tons.
- 6. There are five billion lights on the Eiffel Tower.
- 7. The French have a nickname for the tower: La Dame de Fer, "the Iron Lady:"







Pilot Panda

If you could travel anywhere, where would you like Pilot Panda to take you?









Pirate Panda




Rambo Panda

Bring out your greens for this jungle scene.








RBG Panda

RBG, we concur!






Pandalorian Panda

Unlike the character in the series, no one is ever alone at BigPanda. We even build collaboration into our platform!









Sporty Panda



Bobby Panda


English policemen were called "bobbies" in honor of Robert Peel who set up the first organized police service in London, 1829. Bobby is short for Robert.

This Bobby is guarding the Elizabeth Tower, also known as Big Ben.

Big Ben is the nickname for the Great Bell of the clock at the north end of the Palace of Westminster in London and is usually extended to refer to both the clock and the clock tower. The tower is officially known as Elizabeth Tower, renamed to celebrate the Diamond Jubilee of Elizabeth II in 2012; previously, it was known simply as the Clock Tower.

A British cultural icon, the tower is one of the most prominent symbols of the United Kingdom and is often in the establishing shot of films set in London.

While London skies are usually grey, Bobby Panda and Big Ben deserve some color!




